

- a **gym & wellness center**




LOCATION AND ROUTES

A STRATEGIC HUB IN THE MEDITERRANEAN BASIN

Capo d'Orlando Marina occupies a privileged position along Sicily's northern Tyrrhenian coastline.

Located just 14 nautical miles from the Aeolian Islands, it is among the **fastest and most convenient embarkation points** for the archipelago.

Its centrality within the Mediterranean makes it an ideal base for both short passages and extended cruising itineraries, connecting Sicily with many of the region's most prestigious destinations.




SERVICES AND FACILITIES

TECHNOLOGY, SAFETY AND COMFORT — ON BOARD AND ASHORE

With **553 berths** accommodating yachts up to **50 meters LOA** and draughts between **3.5 and 5 meters**, Capo d'Orlando Marina delivers a full suite of **premium nautical services**, engineered to meet the expectations of modern yachting.

The infrastructure is designed to ensure **operational continuity**, efficient maneuvering, exceptional security standards and high comfort throughout the stay.



NAUTICAL SERVICES

- **24/7 mooring assistance** with trained dock staff
- **Water and shore-power** at all berths
- **Integrated fire-suppression network** and full-area CCTV
- **Fuel dock** with petrol, marine diesel and high-flow diesel
- **Professional underwater services** and **real-time weather station**
- **Caveau bateaux** (secure storage for personal equipment)
- **Guest-only restrooms and showers**, plus self-service laundry
- **High-speed dedicated Wi-Fi** across the marina



BOATYARD

TECHNICAL SERVICES, REFIT AND STORAGE

A fully equipped, **7,500 sqm shipyard** supports the needs of private yachts and charter fleets.

Direct access from the docks ensures **fast turnaround times** and seamless coordination with the marina's operational staff.

The shipyard handles routine and extraordinary maintenance, as well as full refit programs.



Taormina is a jewel of the Ionian Sea. Its ancient Greek Theatre overlooks the coastline, while Corso Umberto winds through gardens, boutiques and terraces with views of Mount Etna — a destination where elegance, culture and Mediterranean beauty converge.


Tindari and Marinello Lakes

Tindari hosts the Sanctuary of the Black Madonna and an impressive archaeological site overlooking the sea.

Below the cliffs lie the Marinello Lakes, a protected nature reserve known for its transient sandbars and reflective pools.



Etna and Wine Routes

A two-hour drive brings you to Mount Etna, Europe's highest active volcano. Its volcanic landscapes, forests and craters form one of Italy's most extraordinary natural environments.



Cefalù is one of the most iconic towns of the Tyrrhenian coast, featuring UNESCO-listed Arab-Norman architecture, golden beaches and a vibrant historic center.
